Class 2 Trip: The Great Fire of London

Dear Parents,

To support our classroom learning of The Great Fire of London, we would like to take the children in Class 2 on an educational visit to Aston Museum: Wednesday 6th November 2019.

During the visit, the children will discuss how the fire started by looking at bread ovens in the kitchen and discover why the flames spread so quickly and how they were eventually put out. Pupils will dress up as key figures, including Thomas Farriner and King Charles II, and explore a bedroom like the one Samuel Pepys slept in. They'll also learn 17th-century fire-fighting methods, trying their hands at lifting the heavy fire hook and passing a leather fire bucket along a line.

The children are required to arrive in school between 08.40 – 08.55 on the morning of Wednesday 6th November, and will be back in school for usual collection time of 15.15.

The cost for the trip is £14.00 per child. All payments must be made via Eduspot and payment complete before the duration of the trip. Please contact the school office if you are experiencing any difficulties with payment.
